Each school review generates a number of key improvement strategies to inform continuous improvement in all state schools. The next steps are...

- Collaboratively develop a clear school vision, aligned to the strategic plan, with measurable targets which will guide school decision making and the direction moving forward.
- Further develop teacher knowledge of the Australian Curriculum (AC) and understanding of P-12 curriculum, assessment and reporting framework requirements to inform curriculum design and delivery.
- Refine the whole-school curriculum assessment and reporting plan to ensure horizontal and vertical alignment and consistency across the three levels of planning with the AC.
- Embed processes of the Professional Learning Teams to further develop staff capability around curriculum, teaching and learning to continue to lift student academic outcomes.
- Develop moderation processes at multiple junctures to share expectations regarding student learning, align unit plans with assessment tasks, and ensure consistent and accurate reporting.
